District Overview

St. Vrain Valley Schools is the educational home of more than 32,000 of Colorado's students. St. Vrain Valley is the seventh largest school district in the state and operates 57 schools and programs that are spread over 411 square miles, serving 13 geographically diverse communities. All traditional schools in St. Vrain are accredited at the two highest levels with some of the most rigorous graduation requirements in Colorado. St. Vrain Valley Schools is preparing students for the future by giving them a strong competitive advantage that will empower their success in a complex, globalized economy. The district offers 70 Instructional Focus Programs including: Energy, STEM, Engineering and Aerospace, Medical and Bioscience, International Baccalaureate, and Leadership.

School Overview

Niwot High School offers a rigorous college preparatory curriculum and advanced level coursework that consists of Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme (DP), and Niwot Pre-IB (NPIB)/Honors courses. In addition, students have the option to participate in concurrent enrollment which allows them to explore a variety of college courses. Niwot High School has received the John Irwin Award for academic achievement 11 times since 2002. NHS students are supported and challenge by an award-winning staff including Colorado Principal of the Year, Cross Country Coach of the Year, Tennis Coach of the Year, and Koebel Enterprising Teacher of the Year.



IB Focus

- Niwot High School promotes and supports access to the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme, offering both the full diploma and individual IB courses to all students who can benefit from the educational experience.
- 44% of juniors and seniors are accessing at least one IB Class
- 67% of juniors and seniors are accessing at least one AP or IB class

Technology Focus

- All students have access to full-size, personal iPads.
- Clubs include a 3D Printer Club, a Robotics Club, and the district's Up-A-Creek Robotics Team, a school-wide geek squad helping students and staff solve tech issues.
- Computer Science courses include Intro to Computer Programming, Intro to App Development, AP Computer Science Principles, and AP Computer Science.
- Internship opportunities and certification programs are offered at the district's Innovation Center and the Career Elevation and Technology Center.
